What's Happening Now? Understanding the Mass

The Mystery of Faith. In the midst of the prayers to the Father before Communion, the priest makes a declaration: "The mystery of faith." Through the power of the Holy Spirit, he has just changed the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This is the incredible mystery that Jesus first performed at the Last Supper, and we now repeat at every Mass. We then respond by making one of three acclamations, or summary statements, about the essence of our faith: "We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again" or "When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again" or "Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection, you have set us free." All three statements are directly from Scripture, and are to remind us of the salvation that we can receive if we believe in Christ. **Think about:** Do I truly believe that Jesus died on the cross to save me?

Below is a sample of responses made by the RCIA candidates shortly before they were confirmed:

Q: How are you different than when you started the RCIA process?

A: I understand more about what is happening during Mass. I now think about literally being in the presence of God when at church, and look forward to practicing in communion with the understanding I've learned in becoming a Catholic.

Q: What was the most difficult part of the RCIA process for you?

A: Trying to understand the Bible - what it says and what it really means.

Q: What does it mean to you to become Catholic?

A: Becoming Catholic means I can really start growing on my beliefs and celebrating them with my family and friends. To me, that means I have heard my calling from God.
