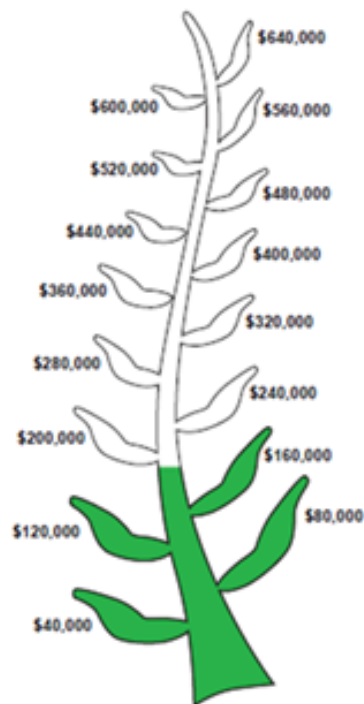
## Grace Family Center Capital Campaign Fundraising Update

### What's Happening Now?? Understanding the Mass

**The Communion Rite** We begin the final preparation to receive the Body and Blood of Christ. The priest says: "At the Savior's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say..." In Matthew 6:5-13, Jesus gives His disciples very specific instructions about when and how to pray. We are to go to our "inner room," in other words, pray from our heart. He then gives us the words that we now call "The Our Father." Although we have this memorized from our childhood, it should not become routine. These words, from Jesus Himself, summarize our praise and petitions to God. He asks us to have an intimate knowledge of God as our **Father**. The implications of God as a provider, protector, and comforter are purposeful. He gives us all that we need, if we only turn to Him and humbly ask it of Him. **Think about:** Take some time to pray this prayer very slowly and meditate on your relationship with God.

### Bible Study



**Priest, Prophet, King** by Fr. Robert Barron. Who was Jesus, and why didn't the Jews accept Him as the Messiah? Fr. Barron talks about the Jewish expectations and why Jesus didn't fit the "mold." This 6-week DVD series will begin on Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30pm and Tuesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, at 1:30pm in the Library. There is no cost, and study materials will be provided.
