

What's Happening Now? Understanding the Mass

The "Lamb of God" (Agnus dei). The night before the Hebrews left their life of slavery in Egypt, they were told to sacrifice a lamb, putting its blood on the door posts of their houses, and eating it for their evening meal. This practice is repeated annually, and is known as the Passover. As the Jews were required to take a spotless, unblemished lamb for this sacrifice, and not break any of its bones during the killing, so Jesus is for us the pure and sinless sacrifice. For Christians, Jesus becomes the sacrificial Lamb, so that we no longer have to repeat this Jewish tradition. Before we receive the Eucharist, we acknowledge His sacrifice that frees us from our slavery to sin. St. John further describes this victory when he explains the celebration in heaven of all those who are worshipping God. (Rev. 5:11-13). Think about: What will it be like to worship God in heaven?
