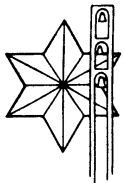

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We have just learned that both Archbishop John Nienstedt and Auxiliary Bishop Lee Piché have resigned from their positions in the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. As I spoke about in my homily last weekend, this is a time for prayer and a time to rely on the virtue of hope.

We pray especially for the victims of child abuse, and for their healing. We also pray for our own Archdiocese, that God would have mercy on us and bring us to the place that He wants us to be at. And, above all, we hope in Jesus Christ, who is our Savior and our Guide.

Included in this week's bulletin, is a letter from Archbishop Bernard Hebda, Coadjutor Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Newark, whom Pope Francis has appointed to serve as the Apostolic Administrator for our Archdiocese until another Archbishop is appointed.

### What's Happening Now? Understanding the Mass

**"Lord, I am not worthy..."** These words come from the story of the Roman centurion who asked Jesus to heal his sick servant. (Matt. 8:5-13) As a Roman soldier, he could not openly practice the Christian faith, but he was a true believer in Jesus. This becomes clear when he humbly tells Jesus that he is not worthy to have Him enter into his house ("under his roof"). But his faith is so strong that he knows that Jesus can cure his servant even without seeing or touching him. Jesus is impressed by this and does cure the servant. This sinful man has very humbly approached Jesus, acknowledging his unworthiness to ask for anything. It is his faith in the healing power of Jesus that results in the saving of his servant's life. **Think about:** Is it with humility and faith that we approach the Eucharistic table?

### Bible Study



This is the last week for the DVD series "Priest, Prophet, and King" by Fr. Robert Barron. He explains how Jesus fulfilled the Old Testament expectation of a new King David, but takes it to a higher level. He will also conclude the series by summarizing how Jesus was the ultimate priest, prophet, and king, and how this leads to our salvation.
