What's Happening Now? Understanding the Mass

Holy Communion After we have proclaimed our unworthiness to receive the Body and Blood of Christ, the priest consumes the Body, saying "May the Body of Christ keep me safe for eternal life." He then consumes the Blood, saying "May the Blood of Christ keep me safe for eternal life." We do not hear these words, but they remind us of the unique role of the priest and his prayer relationship with the Father. Next, those present process towards the altar to receive the Body and/or Blood of Christ. This is done reverently, as indicated in the bow before receiving either the Body or Blood. After receiving, we respond with "Amen," meaning that we affirm and believe that we really have taken Christ into ourselves. **Think about:** How can I make myself more worthy to receive the Body and Blood of Christ?
