Concluding Rites After any announcements, the priest extends his hands and says, "The Lord be with you." And we respond with "And with your spirit." This is the same exchange as at the beginning of the Mass, before the Gospel reading, and before the Communion Rites. It is now repeated at the end, again as a prayer for the priest. We then bow our heads to receive the final blessing: "May almighty God bless you, the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit." We respond with "Amen" as an affirmation of this blessing. The priest then sends us out with the words "Go in peace" or "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord" or something similar. As Jesus told his Apostles, "As the Father has sent me, even so I send you" (John 20:21), we are called to be disciples of Christ. **Think about:** How do I live out my Catholic beliefs?
