Bread from Heaven

In today's first reading, Moses has led the Israelites out of Egypt, away from the life of slavery. For at time there was great joy, but soon they became hungry and dissatisfied, and grumbled to Moses. Because of God's great love and mercy, He rained down "bread from heaven." However, there was a catch – they needed to follow His instructions of only collecting what they needed for that day. God was testing their faith in Him. Could they accept **on faith** that God would provide for them every day so there would be no need to stock-pile extra food for the next day?

In the Gospel of John, Jesus reminds the crowd who followed Him that it was God, not Moses, who gave the food from heaven. In the Exodus reading, this bread satisfied only the physical needs of the people. In the Gospel reading, Jesus raises the bar and tells the crowd that "I am the bread of life." He is the source of eternal life, which is what we all should be craving. Our goal on earth is to get to heaven. If you have faith in Him, you will not hunger or thirst, but will have life with Jesus. Today, give thanks to God for giving the gift of faith in Him, and for giving us His Son, Jesus, in the Eucharist.
