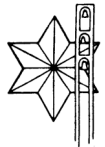

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

“As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.” These are the words spoken by Joshua in this weekend’s first reading. Joshua makes a declaration before the people of Israel saying that no matter what happens he and his family will follow God and he tells them that they must make a fundamental decision: either they will follow God or they will not. This is a decision that every human being has to make and the decision we make forms our lives. In choosing to follow God, we are putting our lives in the hands of the one who made us and has a plan for us. God wants us to fall in love with Him.

Fr. Pedro Arrupe was the twenty-eighth superior of the Jesuit order. He said this, “What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination, will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the morning, what you do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, who you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in love, stay in love, and it will decide everything.”

May we truly fall in love with God and commit our lives to Him and declare with Joshua “As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.”

I will be attending the first profession of a religious sister for whom I have been spiritual director for the last couple of years. ### Mary Consecration Bible Study



Leading up to the re-dedication of Our Lady of the Lake Church on October 25<sup>th</sup> by Bishop Andrew Cozzens, we will prepare for this event by focusing on Mary and how she can lead us to a better understanding of her Son, Jesus. Using the text of Michael Gaitley, [33 Days to Morning Glory](#), we will look at four saints who were particularly devoted to her: St. Louis de Montfort, St. Maximilian Kolbe, St. Mother Teresa, and St. John Paul II. During the 33 days prior to the dedication, you will be asked to take approximately 10 minutes per day to read and reflect on a short devotion contained in this book. The weekly classes are offered as an opportunity to answer any questions about the saints and explore their lives in more depth. Classes will be held on Mondays at 6:30pm and Tuesdays at 1:30pm and begin on September 21<sup>st</sup> and September 22<sup>nd</sup>.
