"Adoration is essentially an embrace with Jesus in which I say to him: I am yours, and I ask you, please stay with me always." -Pope Benedict XVI

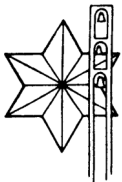

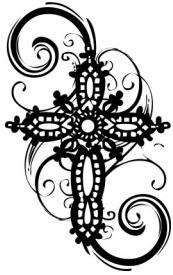
