Fr. Tony Updates:

- **Adult Ed position** – So far no strong candidates.
- **Strategic Planning** - On Dec. 3rd, we will discuss: “Where have we been, where are we now, where would we like to be?”
Initial ideas and thoughts for this meeting following:
 - ✓ See strategic savings plan set in place to see us through any future financial issues
 - ✓ How do we get people engaged?
 - ✓ Continue cohesive planning between groups, committees and school
 - ✓ Reach out to inactive members. Find out how to bring them back.

Liaison Reports:

- **Stewardship** – Discussed this year’s Annual Stewardship Sign-up (Ministry Fair.) A total of 177 volunteer spots were entered into the Church database. 162 of those were new people interested in volunteering.
- **School** – 124 students enrolled. Middle school parent night 10/24. Rake-a-thon and Spaghetti Dinner this week.
- **Finance** - Ambassador School Fundraiser in November. \$70,000 profit on Festival.
- **Scouts** – Registered for summer camp in Many Point in northern MN. Volunteering at Feed My Starving Children. Highway clean up takes place this month.
- **Social Action Committee** – looking to raise 1,000 pairs of socks for the homeless.
- **Maintenance** – 5 new members from ministry fair. Need a vendor to hang the School sign. Have hundreds of church tiles stored that can be used to replace cracked tiles. Tree work in progress.
- **Knights** – 10/28 is celebration of 50th Anniversary.

Administrator’s Report:

- **Financials** - Still a bit behind in income. Expenses are a slightly under budget.
