Becoming Neighbors

Amid the busyness of preparing for our trip to Guatemala, I didn't put much thought into how this year might be different for me. I've been on many mission trips as both a leader and a participant, but I've never been to the same place twice. Returning this year, the trip was a different kind of visit for me. Last year when I went, I had a lot to soak in. Having gone again, I now know why Fr. Tony has been so eager to bring a group to Guatemala every year.

St. John wrote that "whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen" (1 John 4:20). It is a reminder for us to love God by loving those around us, but last week I realized that it is also a call to truly see our brothers and sisters. When we go to a mission once, we are able to help others and to see a completely different life than we have lived. By making ongoing service in San Lucas a priority for our parish, we have the opportunity to be more: to become neighbors with the people there, to really know and see them as our brothers and sisters.

I hope to be able to bring many of you with us to the San Lucas Mission in the years to come, but even though the whole parish cannot go, I am hopeful that we can also find ways to bridge the gap between the people of San Lucas and the people of OLL. When we tell you stories from mission trips or raise money for the trip, I hope it will become not just "some mission" but *our* mission, a mission of Our Lady of the Lake. I'm looking forward to the challenge of finding ways to make that happen, but if you're excited to get started, I encourage you to begin by asking someone who went about their experience. I invite you especially to ask one of the teens who attended. I'm so very proud of each one of them; they were fantastic, and they have some incredible insights.

Thank you for your prayers, well wishes, and financial support for our trip. You are a part of the work we did, and you were remembered in our prayers at daily Mass.
