Jesus' Final Journey to Jerusalem

Today's Gospel reading begins with Jesus "resolutely determined" to travel to Jerusalem. He knows what is waiting for Him there, but that does not deter Him from continuing on. Because of His great love for us, He is willing to complete His earthly mission of suffering and death for our redemption and salvation.

Jesus must also prepare the disciples for the challenges that lie ahead, knowing that He will not be with them much longer. In the Gospel, we hear that Jesus wanted to enter a Samaritan village, but He is rejected by them. The disciples want to call down fire from heaven to punish them, as Elijah had done to his enemies in the Old Testament (1 Kings 1:10-12). But Jesus refuses their request, demonstrating to them His commandment to love your neighbor, including your enemies (Gal. 5:13-14).

The message for us is that our goal on this earth is to get to Jerusalem (heaven); Jesus shows us the way. We must face all of the trials and sufferings that are put before us, knowing that Jesus has already gone before us and experienced all of it. Sometimes, we, too, feel that we have nowhere to rest our heads, no place to find comfort and peace. But when Jesus calls us to follow Him, we must accept all of the terms and conditions of discipleship, even the love of enemies. So, don't stop following Him or turn to look back, as hard as it may be. Stay focused on the path that leads to heaven. Jesus is waiting for us there!

The illness passed and after his ordination, he came to West Bend as pastor in 1898. For over a decade, he stockpiled rocks and precious stones. 
