Lake Minnetonka Shores Ministry

Ministry of Holy Mass and Holy Communion

OLL ministry at Lake Minnetonka Shores (LMS) is our way of being present with residents and staff there, and more than that: our ministry involves mutual faith-sharing, building relationships, and growing God's kingdom.

While this ministry has had a long history, you may wonder what it involves. Our 25 volunteers are scheduled throughout the year, usually six each Thursday morning. Each volunteer is assigned to a group: Hope, Joy, Peace & Faith. We have Mass at LMS at 10:00am bi-monthly. The Hope and Peace groups meet in the chapel at 9:30am, invite & escort residents in the transitional care unit to Mass, attend Mass with them, and assist in returning residents to their rooms. Other residents throughout the facility are always invited to Mass as well.

On the other Thursdays, the Joy & Faith days, volunteers meet at 9:00am in the chapel for prayer and Holy Communion followed by each visiting five or six residents, praying with them and offering them Holy Communion.

Residents in independent housing and other areas in the facility are invited to participate in a 10:00am Communion Service. The prayer booklet used in the Communion Services follows themes, for example: Jesus, Our Good Shepherd, Prayer for Faith, Trust in the Lord, Prayer for Healing, Jesus' Sacred Heart. Communion ministry is also provided on First Fridays of the month.

Ministry at Lake Minnetonka Shores is a corporal & spiritual work of mercy, a ministry that is so gratifying. If you are interested in serving your brothers and sisters in this way, please contact me at 952-472-1284 x168. We are so grateful for parishioners' witness of Christ's compassion.

(Our manner of receiving Holy Communion comes from ancient times and was described by Cyril of Jerusalem in the early centuries of the Church.) After a brief time of adoration after Holy Communion, we stand for the concluding rites, indicating our readiness to leave as a worshipping community and take up the individual challenge to live the liturgy we have celebrated.


